#### HAS YOUR CONTACT INFORMATION CHANGED?

If any of your contact information has changed in the last year, **call the Health Benefits Center (877-466-9236)** to update your information. This is the system of record for Intel retirees and will ensure you receive the Annual Enrollment Guide, W-2s and other documents on time.

#### INTEL BADGE REPLACEMENTS ARE NO LONGER AVAILABLE MORE THAN 10 YEARS AFTER YOU LEAVE INTEL



As of August 2021, Intel will no longer provide replacement badges for retirees whose last day was more than ten years prior to the date of the request for replacement. For example, if you retired in March 2008, and you request a badge today, Intel will NOT provide one, because September 2021 is 13 years and 6 months after March 2008. If you retired in August 2014 and request a badge today, Intel WILL provide one, because it's only 7 years and 1 month after August 2014. Purchases from the EPP Store (including McAfee)

are NOT affected, but some purchases from the Employee Discount Store (Beneplace) ARE affected. More about the change here.
