ANNUAL ENROLLMENT EXTENDED THROUGH NOV. 19, 2021 The new Retiree Benefit Annual Enrollment period will be October 25 through November 19.

Due to an unforeseen issue with Intel's new vendor and their print company, the Retiree packets (Guide, IRMP Insert, and Legal Notice) have been delayed. Intel expects the guides to be received by the

Retiree population by October 29. Due to this delay, Intel is extending the Retiree Benefit Annual Enrollment period by one week.

INTEL IS TRANSITIONING TO A NEW MY HEALTH BENEFITS PLATFORM VENDOR - YOUR AR

The transition will start with a New Enrollment Experience for Annual Enrollment in October of 2021 and be complete January 21,2022. It is expected that all retirees read and take a few actions (some during Annual Enrollment for 2022 and a few next year) described in the **IRMP Transition Document.** The last day to submit claims through the current Your Spending Account for 2021 expenses is **December 23, 2021**. Once your SERMA



balance is transferred and updated in MyChoice Accounts on January 21, 2022 you will be able to submit 2021 claims to MyChoice Accounts until May 31, 2022.

If you use SERMA – this is your AR:

- Review the enclosed <u>IRMP Transition Document</u>. for directions on how to log in. Once logged in, you will see additional details about setting up your SERMA, submitting claims, setting up auto-pay, and more.
- If you or your eligible dependents are enrolled in an Aon Retiree Health Exchange plan and utilizing your Auto-Pay Option, this will end December 31, 2021. Effective with your January 1, 2022 premiums, you will need to set-up SERMA



AutoPay (reimbursement) via the New Health Benefits portal. If you do nothing, you risk termination of coverage due to non-payment.
