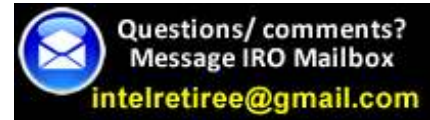

Question: I just received an email stating my McAfee Subscription is expiring. Is this spam email or as an Intel Retiree, is my McAfee subscription expiring? If it is, how do I renew my subscription?



Answer: There seems to be an increase in these types of emails, and many are not legitimate. You should log in to your McAfee account to verify if your subscription is truly expiring and not use any links in the email. The IRO website has the information you need to renew.
