RETIREES RECEIVING A W-2 FROM INTEL IN 2023 – IF YOUR MAILING ADDRESS HAS CHANGED UPDATE IT NOW

Intel mails your W-2 to the mailing address that they have on record for you as of the end of the previous year. It will be **mailed by January 31 every year**.

NOTE: To ensure that you receive your W-2 you must make <u>Home Address Changes</u> in the first week of December

If you have not received your W-2 by the middle of February, call the Get HR Help 800 number (**1-800-238-0486**) to request a copy. Select the payroll option or option zero to be connected to a Get HR Help representative. Remember to use the voicemail/call back option if hold times are long. If you have received your W-2 and have questions, you can also request a W-2 Breakdown Letter which details what was included in each box on your W-2.


INTEL, CUTTING COSTS, OFFERS UNPAID LEAVE TO FACTORY WORKERS WORLDWIDE

By Mike Rogoway | The Oregonian/OregonLive - Dec. 02, 2022, 1:48 p.m. Intel is offering thousands of manufacturing employees <u>three months of</u> <u>unpaid leave</u>, another effort to trim its budget amid a historic sales decline.

According to the Financial Times, the program was available to factory workers in Ireland. Intel said the same program is available at its facilities worldwide, including in the U.S. The company declined to say whether employees retain benefits while on leave.


