Intel and the Gordon and Betty Moore Foundation announced that company co-founder <u>Gordon Moore has passed away at the age of 94</u>. The foundation reported he died peacefully on Friday, March 24, 2023, surrounded by family at his home in Hawaii. Moore , who set the course for the future of the semiconductor industry,

devoted his later years to philanthropy.

The Intel Foundation met with IRO to provide an update on the significant restructuring <u>changes</u> to their Donation
