Dear Employees and Retirees,

As we approach the end of 2024 and turn to 2025, the Intel Foundation is taking the opportunity to reassess its strategy. Our goal is to improve program efficiency, amplify our collective impact, and align with industry standards and best practices.

We are carefully reviewing our focus areas, which include education/STEM programming, community engagement and employee involvement. Based on our current funding levels, we plan to adjust programs for the next two years, with a full reassessment scheduled for 2027. This review will lead to adjustments in the matching contributions provided by the Intel Foundation. We aim to share updates by early 2025.

We understand that potential changes may influence employee charitable decisions. Therefore, we are providing this advance notice to ensure transparency and invite your feedback.
